## **Inverclyde Windfarm Fund 2022**

### **Case Study – Children in Poverty Inverclyde**

---

#### **Amount Awarded: £1,000**

“We spent the grant on Tesco F&F vouchers to purchase warm clothing (woolly jumpers, woollen hats and gloves, and puffer-type jackets/coats) and distributed these to local nurseries, health visitors and social care for families with young children who were identified and prioritised by them.

Our organisation merited great publicity locally in our compassionate provision of the clothing and reinforced our engagement in the community. Feedback from our partners was wholesome and generous with all detailing how welcome and valued the warm clothing was for their children. Furthermore, by purchasing items from a reputable retailer, their eco-friendly practices would be in-keeping with protecting the environment.

The project in itself was very simplistic and required basic management and we are immensely grateful to the Windfarm Fund for this grant.”
