Case Study – BOUNCE Basketball Inverclyde

Amount Awarded: £1,000.00

“As a new club, the funding was utilised in three ways:

1. We purchased club strips, complete with embroidered logos, and have made these available to our members at a heavily subsidised and affordable cost. The complete kit costs £30 per kit, and we offer them to the kids at £10 per kit.
2. We held an end of season family night to benefit the wider family groups. This was held in a local establishment and was very well received by all.
3. We were able to purchase some new training equipment for moving back indoors.

This grant has allowed our club to establish itself within the local community quicker than we could have imagined.

Due to the interest in our club through word of mouth, we ran a Summer Camp for non-members to engage with 25 more kids who wanted to learn a bit more about basketball. In addition to this, we have a waiting list of around 30 kids who would like to be involved in this.
