Amount Awarded: £1,000.00

“We are a local football team consisting of children aged 7-8. The grant helped us to buy every player a new strip for the season ahead.

The grant has made a huge difference to our football club. Some of our parents have been hit financially by the pandemic, resulting in them being unable to pay their child’s weekly fees. This has then had a knock-on effect with the club funds.
